FINANCES

In recognition of the impact COVID-19 continues to have on the creative community, fees for this online CCL have been significantly reduced. We have set a suggested digital participant fee of SEK 3,000.

We suggest anyone working for an organisation with SEK 2,000,000+ annual turnover pay, but applicants are able to state if they are unable to as part of the application. Independent artists/freelancers and those working for non-profit, charity, or grassroots organisations with smaller turnovers are not expected to pay.

The fee covers full participation in the digital programme; inclusion in the on-going network of CCL alumni including three post-course webinars; potential to apply for one of several CCL Action 'seed grants' of up to SEK 18,000 (note that only independent freelancers/artists or not-for-profit organisations will be eligible to apply for the seed grants) ; and attendance at a CCL Summit in Stockholm in autumn 2022.

We ***DO*** expect applicants to commit to attend all the digital sessions that are a part of the programme. To ensure the experience for participants remains faithful to an intense leadership development programme, we are still limiting the number of participants to 24, despite the shift to an online programme.
